Dear WCPOS V Invited Speaker,

Thank you so much for your patience. WSPOS has made the decision to postpone the 5th World Congress of Paediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus (WCPOS V), in Amsterdam and is now planning on holding it in August 2021, once again in Amsterdam. We would very much like to invite you to speak at your original session, only at WCPOS V August 2021.

Furthermore, there will be a virtual meeting this year called WSPOS World Wide Connect held on 26th September 2020 with a unique flavour, we at WSPOS believe expertise resides all over the world and while all the world can tune in to World Wide Connect, the focus of presentations will move across the world following daylight hours.

This means that on the 26th September we start at **09.00 am Australian Eastern Standard Time** and after 6 hours moves to **Indian Standard Time** and after another 6 hours, we move on to **British Summer Time** before finally making the move across the Atlantic to **US Eastern Standard Time**.
